A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend certain public laws appropriating funds for projects in the State of Yap; specifically, to further amend Public Law No. 4-23, as amended, by further amending section 4, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-46, 5-74, 8-89, and 10-36; to further amend Public Law No. 5-59, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-116, 6-76, 7-Public Law No. 5-59, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-116, 6-76, 7-66, 8-90, and 10-36, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-116, 6-76, 8-90, and 10-36; and to further amend Public Law No. 6-67, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 7-77, 8-92, 9-120, and 10-36, by further amending section 3, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-92, and 10-36; all for the purpose of extending the lapse dates on certain funds appropriated therein; and for other purposes.

1	Section 1. Section 4 of Public Law No. 4-23, as
2	amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-46, 5-74, 8-89, and 10-36, is
3	hereby further amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 4. All funds appropriated by this act
5	shall be allotted, managed, administered, and
6	accounted for in accordance with applicable law,
7	including, but not limited to, the Financial
8	Management Act of 1979. The allottee of the funds

17	appropriated. The authority of the allottees to
18	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall
19	lapse as of September 30, 199 8 9."
20	Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law No. 5-59, as
21	amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-116, 6-76, 8-90, and 10-36, is
22	hereby further amended to read as follows:
23	"Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act
24	shall be allotted, managed, administered, and
25	accounted for in accordance with applicable law,

1	including, but not limited to, the Financial
2	Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be the
3	Governor of Yap State, who shall be responsible
4	for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof
5	as may be necessary, are used solely for the
6	purpose specified in this act, and that no
7	obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
8	appropriated. The allottee may reprogram up to 15
9	percent to and from the funds appropriated under
10	each subsection of section 2 of this act. The
11	authority of the allottees to obligate funds
12	appropriated by this act shall lapse as of
13	September 30, 199 <u>89</u> ."
14	Section 3. Section 3 of Public Law No. 6-67, as
15	amended by Public Laws Nos. 8-92, and 10-36, is hereby
16	further amended to read as follows:
17	"Section 3. All funds appropriated by this act
18	shall be allotted, managed, administered, and
19	accounted for in accordance with applicable law,
20	including, but not limited to, the Financial
21	Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall have
22	the authority to reprogram up to 15 percent to and
23	from the funds appropriated under each subsection
24	of section 1 of this act. The allottee shall be
25	the Governor of the State of Yap, who shall be
