## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to section 6 of article IX of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia to provide that not less than fifty percent of the net revenue from fishery resources be shared with the states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. <u>Proposed amendment</u> . It is hereby
2	proposed that section 6 of article IX of the Constitution
3	of the Federated States of Micronesia be amended to read
4	as follows:
5	"Section 6. Net revenue derived from ocean floor
6	mineral resources exploited under Section 2(m) shall
7	be divided equally between the national government
8	and the appropriate state government. Not less than
9	fifty percent of the net revenue from fishery
10	resources exploited under Section 2(m) shall be paid
11	to the states, each state receiving an equal share."
12	Section 2. Procedure. This act shall become
13	effective upon its passage by Congress as an act of the
14	Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, and it
15	shall be transmitted to the President for action in
16	accordance with chapter 7 of title 1 of the Code of the
17	Federated States of Micronesia. This proposed amendment
18	shall become part of the Constitution following completion
19	of the procedures, including its ratification by the
20	people, as required by the Constitution and law.
