## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 24 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended, by further amending section 404, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-11 and 9-057, for the purpose of requiring that all foreign fishing agreements include a provision prohibiting any commercial fishing within twenty-four miles of the territory of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 404 of title 24 of the Code of the 1 Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 6-11 2 3 and 9-057, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 404. Foreign fishing agreements - Terms. 4 5 All foreign fishing agreements shall have the following 6 minimum terms: 7 (1) The foreign party and the owner or operator of any fishing vessel shall acknowledge the exclusive fishery
  - management authority of the Federated States of Micronesia within the Exclusive Economic Zone; (2) The foreign party or the owner or operator of any
  - fishing vessel fishing, as appropriate, pursuant to such agreement shall:
  - (a) comply with the requirements of this title, all regulations issued pursuant to this title and all other applicable laws and regulations;
  - (b) permit any officer authorized to enforce the provisions of this title, to board and search or inspect any vessel at any time and make arrests and seizures provided for in section 508 of this title whenever such officer has reasonable cause to believe, as a result of such a search or inspection, that any such vessel or any person has committed an act prohibited by this title;
  - (c) permit such officer to examine and make negotiations on any permit issued pursuant to sections

- (d) allow and assist any authorized officer to enforce the provisions of this title, regulations made thereunder and any other applicable laws or regulations;
- (e) immediately comply with every instruction given by an authorized officer, facilitate safe boarding, and facilitate the inspection of the vessel, gear, equipment, records, fish and fish products;
- (f) allow and assist authorized observers to board the vessel for scientific, monitoring, compliance and other functions, and have full access to, and the use of, facilities and equipment on board the vessel which the authorized observer may determine is necessary to carry out his duties; have full access to the bridge, fish on board and areas which may be used to hold, process, weigh and store fish; remove samples; have full access to the vessel's records, including its logs and documentation for the purpose of inspection and copying and gather any other information relating to fisheries in the Exclusive Economic Zone;
- (g) not assault, obstruct, resist, delay, refuse boarding to, intimidate, or interfere with an authorized officer or authorized observer in the performance of his duties;

1	(h) display any permit or permit number issued for
2	any such vessel pursuant to sections 109 through 111 of
3	this title or any documentation required to be displayed
4	under foreign fishing agreements in the wheelhouse of
5	such vessel;
6	(i) ensure that appropriate position-fixing and
7	identification equipment shall be installed and
8	maintained in working order on each such vessel;
9	(j) ensure that the vessel is marked in accordance
10	with regulations leased by the authority while within the
11	Exclusive Economic Zone;
12	(k) require that the National Government of the
13	Federated States of Micronesia shall be reimbursed for
14	the cost of authorized observers;
15	(1) appoint and maintain an agent within the
16	Federated States of Micronesia who is authorized to
17	receive and respond to any legal process issued in the
18	Federated States of Micronesia with respect to such owner
19	or operator of such vessel;
20	(m) not, in any year, exceed such party's
21	allocation of the total allowable level of foreign
22	fishing, in the event allocations are established in
23	accordance with this title; [and]
24	(n) use components of vessels monitoring systems
25	as directed by the President of the Federated States of

1	Micronesia: and
2	(o) agree to refrain from, and refrain from, any
3	commercial fishing within twelve (12) miles of the
4	outermost limits of the territorial waters of the
5	Federated States of Micronesia.
6	(3) Foreign parties will:
7	(a) apply, pursuant to section 109 of this title,
8	for any required permits;
9	(b) deliver promptly to the owner or operator of
10	the appropriate fishing vessel any permit which is issued
11	under that section for such vessel; and
12	(c) abide by the requirement that no foreign
13	fishing will be permitted in the Exclusive Economic Zone
14	without a valid and applicable permit, except as provided
15	by foreign fishing agreements concluded pursuant to this
16	chapter, and that all conditions and restrictions of the
17	permit, or any applicable foreign fishing agreement, are
18	complied with."
19	Section 2. This act shall become law upon approval by the
20	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
21	law without such approval.
