#### Public Law No. 15 04

#### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 14-80, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 14-95, 14-99 and 14-104, and 15-01, the FY 2007 budget, by further amending sections 1, 2, 3, 5, 8 and 9 thereof, for the purpose of appropriating \$1,031,954 in supplemental funding from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2007, to provide for the operations of the Executive and Legislative Branch, National Agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies, and contributions, Capital and Human Resource Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
