AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 12-50, as amended, by amending sections 13 and 16 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 13 of Public Law No. 12-50, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 12-53, 12-74, 13-1, 13-17, 14-65, 14-71 and 14-94 is hereby further amended to read as follows: "Section 13. Capital and Human Resource Development. The sum of \$12,302,572, or so much thereof as may be 5 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal 7 year ending September 30, 2003, for capital improvement, 8 development programs and projects, and human resource 9 10 development. The sum appropriated under this section shall be apportioned as follows: 11 (1) College of Micronesia - FSM 12 13 (a) Operations of the College of 14 Micronesia-FSM, including planning, construction of new facilities and maintenance of the 15 newly completed multi-purpose gymnasium...\$ 3,220,000 16 (b) Student assistance for tuition 17

9	Section 2. Section 16 of Public Law No. 12-50, as amended and
10	restated by Public Law No. 12-53 and amended by Public Laws Nos.
11	13-01 and 13-17, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
12	"Section 16. Allotment and management of funds and
13	<pre>lapse date.</pre>
14	(1) General Provisions.
15	(a) All funds appropriated by this act shall be
16	allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in
17	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
18	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979;
19	(b) The allottees shall be responsible for
20	ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be
21	necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in
22	this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess
23	of the sum appropriated.
24	(2) Allottees. The allottees of the funds
25	appropriated by this act are as follows:

1	(a) section 2 - the allottee of these funds
2	shall be the President of the Federated States of
3	Micronesia;
4	(b) section 3 - the allottee of these funds
5	shall be the Speaker of the Congress of the Federated
6	States of Micronesia;
7	(c) section 4 - the allottee of these funds
8	shall be the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the
9	Federated States of Micronesia;
10	(d) section 5 - the allottee of these funds
11	shall be the Public Auditor of the Federated States of
12	Micronesia;
13	(e) section 6 through 13 - the allottee of these
14	funds shall be the President of the Federated States of
15	Micronesia; EXCEPT THAT for the following subsections of
16	section 6 through 13 of this act, the allottees shall
17	be:
18	(i) section 8, subsection (5) - the
19	allottee of these funds shall be the President of the
20	Federated States of Micronesia;
21	(ii) section 8, subsection (8)(a) through
22	(8)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be Chief
23	Justice of the respective state;
24	(iii) section 13, subsection (1)(a) through
25	(1)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the

1	President of the College of Micronesia-FSM;
2	(iv) section 13, subsection (2)(a) through
3	(2)(d) - the allottee of these funds shall be the
4	Governor of the respective state, EXCEPT THAT the
5	allottee for funds allocated to Chuuk State under
6	subsection (2)(c) shall be the Chuuk State Commission or
7	Improvement Projects and the allottee for funds
8	allocated to Yap State under subsection (2)(d)(ii) shall
9	be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia;
10	and
11	(v) Section 13, subsection (15) - the
12	allottee of these funds shall be the Chief Justice of
13	the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia.
14	(vi) Section 13, subsection (17) (b) $-$ the
15	allottee of these funds shall be the Chuuk State
16	Commission on Improvement Project.
17	(3) Lapse Dates. The authority of the allottees to
18	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as
19	of September 30, 2003, EXCEPT that funds appropriated
20	under section 13 of this act shall not lapse and the
21	funds appropriated under section 7, subsection (2) of
22	this act shall lapse as of April 30, 2004."
