AN ACT

To further amend sections 1 and 2 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein for Chuuk State At-Large, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended by
2 Public Laws Nos. 14-72, 14-82, 14-91, 14-101 and 15-06, is hereby
3 further amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 1. The sum of \$2.1 million, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the
6 General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006 for projects
8 and programs in each state of the Federated States of
9 Micronesia. The funds appropriated under section 1 of
10 this act shall be apportioned on the basis of \$150,000
11 per member of Congress as follows:


18 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 14-67, as amended by
19 Public Laws Nos. 14-72, 14-82 and 14-101, is hereby further
20 amended to read as follows:

21 "Section 2. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
22 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
23 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
24 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
25 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979 and the

1 amended Compact of Free Association between the United
2 States Government and the Government of the Federated
3 States of Micronesia and its related agreements. The
4 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
5 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
6 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that
7 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
8 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
9 under subsections (4)(a),(c),(d) and (f) of section 1 of
10 this act shall be the Chuuk State Commission on
11 Improvement Project. The allottee of the funds
12 appropriated under subsection (4)(b) of section 1 of
13 this act shall be the Mortlocks Development Commission.
14 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
15 (4)(e) of section 1 of this act shall be the Mayor of
16 Polle. The allottee of funds appropriated under
17 subsections 1, 2 and 3 of Section 1 of this act shall be
18 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
19 except that the allottee of funds appropriated under
20 subsections (2)(b), (2)(c), 2(d) and (2)(f) of Section 1
21 of this act shall be the Governor of the State of Yap.
22 The authority of the allottee to obligate funds
23 appropriated by this act shall lapse on 30 September
24 2008."
25

1 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
3 becoming law without such approval.
