### PUBLIC LAW No. 16-25

#### AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia a supplemental funding in the amount of \$2,633,632 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, by amending sections 1, 2, 3, 6, 8, and 9 of Public Law No. 16-7, as amended by Public Law No. 16-20, and for other purposes.
