I hereby transmit the following Congressional Act, which I have approved to become Public Law No. 16-60:

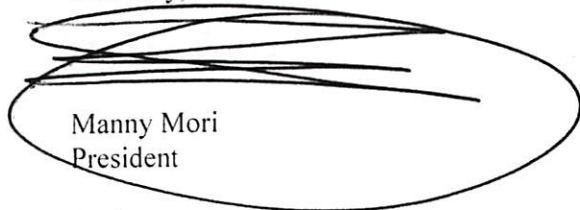
Congressional Act No. 16-62, "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$767,192 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2011, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2 AND 3, 6 AND 8 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-43, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 16-48 AND 16-53, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Clearly this congressional act does not fully address the inevitable shortfall faced by the Executive Branch to support FY 2011 operation and various essential public services. Nevertheless, I have approved this supplemental budget as a step forward with a view towards continued cooperation between our branches of government.

I urge Congress to consider budgetary items omitted from this act during its future deliberations and to maintain the level of projected revenue of \$39 million as provided in the President's FY 2011 Budget submission on April 1, 2010.

AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia supplemental funding in the total amount of \$767,192 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, by amending sections 1, 2 and 3, 6 and 8 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-48 and 16-53, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1       Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 16-48 and 16-53, is hereby further amended to read
