Dear Speaker Figir:

I hereby transmit the following Congressional Act, which I have approved to become Public Law No. 16-60:

Congressional Act No. 16-62, "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$767,192 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2011, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1, 2 AND 3, 6 AND 8 OF PUBLIC LAW NO. 16-43, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 16-48 AND 16-53, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Clearly this congressional act does not fully address the inevitable shortfall faced by the Executive Branch to support FY 2011operation and various essential public services. Nevertheless, I have approved this supplemental budget as a step forward with a view towards continued cooperation between our branches of government.

I urge Congress to consider budgetary items omitted from this act during its future deliberations and to maintain the level of projected revenue of \$39 million as provided in the President's FY 2011 Budget submission on April 1, 2010.

PUBLIC LAW No. 16- 60 1

AN ACT

To appropriate from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia supplemental funding in the total amount of \$767,192 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2011, by amending sections 1, 2 and 3, 6 and 8 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-48 and 16-53, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by 2 Public Laws Nos. 16-48 and 16-53, is hereby further amended to read 3 as follows:

The purpose of this act is to "Section 1. to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the capacity building sector; \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the private sector development sector; and \$-0shall be deemed to come from funds available under the amended Compact from the infrastructure sector." Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-43, as amended by Section 2.
