## AN ACT

To appropriate \$40,491,992 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions, and Capital and Human Resources Development; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 14 from funds available under the amended Compact from the health sector
- 15 subject to the receipt of Grant Awards under the amended Compact;
- 16 \$-0- shall be deemed to come from funds available under the
