Dear Speak Halbert:

We are returning to Congress the following Congressional Act as Public Law No. 18-35:

Congressional Act No. 18-34, entitled: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF \$4,900,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND OF THE FEDERTED STATES OF MICRONESIA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATES OF YAP, KOSRAE, POHNPEI AND CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

In transmitting this Public Law No. 18-35, I wish to reiterate my request, which I had asked the Chairman of the Committee to Wait and which I have seen in the Committee report, that a meeting be held to resolve issues that were outlined, specifically the implementation process which begins with the development of the Project Control Document. As I have also mentioned in my most recent letters, including at the meeting with the Committee to Wait, what we have been doing is in conflict with the <u>Udot</u> case. As the President, I must uphold the law as decided in <u>Udot</u>. It has become extremely difficult for us to implement the projects, especially in the absence of public hearings and Committee reports. Therefore, I once again extend the invitation to Congress to meet with me and my relevant staff to quickly resolve these issues. Further delay will only impair the ability to implement the projects on a timely basis.

I offer the President's Conference Room to hold our discussion and will be available all day on Friday, January 17, 2014, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., or please suggest another time and place convenient to you. I look forward to hearing from you.
