Dear Speaker Halbert:

I am returning the following Congressional Act, which became Public Law No. 18-61 without signature:

Congressional Act No. 18-61: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-35, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-49, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 2, 3, 4, 5 AND 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF YAP, KOSRAE, POHNPEI AND CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

I reviewed the above Act, which shows the following characteristics, similar to previous concerns I shared with Congress:

- 1. There was no public hearing or committee report.
- 2. The multiple amendments, without a Committee Report or Public Hearing, result in confusion as to the true intention of Congress for the public projects and programs, and create extreme difficulties in implementation of the projects and programs, such as tracking the multiple changes.

AN ACT
