I am transmitting the following Congressional Acts, which became public laws without signature:

Congressional Act No. 18-114, as Public Law No. 18-111, entitled: "AN ACT TO AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-35, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 18-49, 18-61, 18-63 AND 18-94, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 4 AND 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS IN THE STATE OF POHNPEI, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Congressional Act No. 18-115, as Public Law No. 18-112, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-70, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-98, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 2, 4, 5 AND 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE STATES OF YAP, POHNPEI, AND CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Congressional Act No. 18-113, as Public Law No. 18-113, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-99, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAW NO. 18-106, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 3, 4, 5 AND 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF THE STATES OF KOSRAE, POHNPEI AND CHUUK, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."


The above Acts were passed without committee reports or public hearings. Additionally, there is no indication that the amendments in the Acts were thoroughly examined and considered by Congress. In addition, although this Act calls for a reduction of \$10,000 from the Chuuk At-Large project for Community Infrastructure and Housing Renovation, a

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review of this project shows that it has already been allotted in full. In light of these defects, which are some of the same defects that I indicated in my previous communication to Congress with regard to amendments of public projects and social programs, I have decided not to approve the Acts.

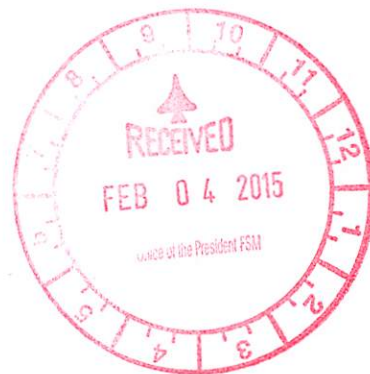

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

AN ACT

Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 18-35, as amended by

1 Public Laws Nos. 18-49 and 18-61, is hereby further amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse  
4 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
5 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
6 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
7 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
8 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
9 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
10 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
11 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
12 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
13 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
14 State provided that the allottee of funds appropriated  
15 under section 2(e) shall be the President of COM-FSM.  
16 The allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and  
17 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated  
18 States of Micronesia or his designee, EXCEPT THAT the  
19 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections (3)(a),  
20 (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), (g), (h), (i), (j), (k), (l),  
21 (m), (n), (o), (p), (q), (r), (s), (t), (u), (v), (w),  
22 (x), (y) and (aq) of section 3 of this act shall be the  
23 Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee of funds  
24 appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b) and  
25 4(3)(e) of section 4 of this act shall be the Pohnpei

1           Transportation Authority and the allottee of funds  
2           appropriated under subsections (4)(3)(h) and (4)(3)(y)  
3           of section 4 of this act shall be the Luhkonmoanlap of  
4           Kitti Municipal government. The allottee of funds  
5           appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(3) of this act  
6           shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his designee.  
7           The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)  
8           of this act shall be the Mortlock Islands Development  
9           Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under  
10          subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern  
11          Namoneas Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
12          appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall be  
13          the Faichuk Development Authority. The allottee of  
14          funds appropriated under subsection 5(6) of this act  
15          shall be the General Manager of the Northwest Island  
16          Development Authority. The authority of the allottee to  
17          obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on  
18          September 30, 2015."



1       Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
