### PUBLIC LAW No. 1 9- 38

#### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-58, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 16-64, 16-72, 17-08, 17-11, 17-20, 17-35, 17-41 and 18-77, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in the State of Chuuk, and for other purposes.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 16-58, as amended by
2	Public Laws Nos. 17-08 and 17-41, is hereby further amended to

7	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 16-58, as amended
8	by Public Laws Nos. 16-64, and 17-11, is hereby further amended
9	to read as follows:
10	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
11	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
12	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
13	accordance with applicable law, including, but not
14	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
15	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
16	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
17	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
18	obligations are incurred in excess of the sum
19	appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under
20	sections 2 and 4 of this act shall be the President of
21	the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee
22	PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds appropriated under
23	section 4(1)(f) shall be the Pohnpei Transportation
24	Authority. The allottee of funds appropriated under
25	section 3 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State.

1	The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(1),
2	5(3) and 5(6) shall be the Governor of Chuuk State. The
3	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(2)
4	shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority. The
5	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(4)
6	shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority.
7	The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(5)
8	shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The funds
9	appropriated by this act shall remain available until
10	fully expended."
11	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
12	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
13	becoming law without such approval.
