PUBLIC LAW No. 1 9- 118

AN ACT

To appropriate \$70,015,981 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2017, to provide funding for the operations of all branches of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia, its agencies, various programs, grants, subsidies and contributions and Capital and Human Resources Development, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. <u>Title</u>. The title of this act is as follows: To
- 2 appropriate the sum of \$70,015,981 from the General Fund of the
- 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
- 4 30, 2017, for the purpose of funding the operations of all branches
- 5 of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia,

- 7 and Capital and Human Resources Development. The National
- 8 Government's share of the Amended Compact funds has been reduced to
- 9 zero; EXCEPT THAT, the National Government will retain 10 percent
- 10 of the Supplemental Education Grant funds as is reflected in the
- 11 budget for the Department of Education. The sum appropriated
- 12 herein shall be apportioned as follows:
