

**PUBLIC LAW No. 19-130**

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 19-121 by amending sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, for the purpose of public projects and social programs in the states of Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

9 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and  
 10 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall  
 11 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for  
 12 in accordance with applicable laws, including, but  
 13 not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.  
 14 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that  
 15 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
 16 are used solely for the purpose specified in this  
 17 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
 18 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of the funds  
 19 appropriated under section 2 of this act shall be the  
 20 Governor of Yap State; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of  
 21 funds appropriated under section 2(k) shall be the  
 22 President of the Federated States of Micronesia. The  
 23 allottee of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4  
 24 of this act shall be the President of the Federated  
 25 States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT

1 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
2 3(a) through 3(r) - shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak  
3 Municipal Government; the allottee of funds  
4 appropriated under subsections 3(aa) - 3(a8) shall be  
5 the Mayor of Lelu Town Government; the allottee of  
6 funds appropriated under subsections 4(1)(1),  
7 4(3)(a), 4(3)(f) and 4(3)(i) of this act shall be the  
8 Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee  
9 of funds appropriated under subsections 4(2)(a),  
10 4(2)(d), 4(2)(e), 4(2)(f), 4(2)(g), 4(2)(h), 4(2)(i),  
11 4(2)(j), 4(2)(k), 4(2)(l) and 4(2)(m) shall be the  
12 Secretary of the Department of Transportation,  
13 Communications and Infrastructure or his designee;  
14 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
15 4(2)(b) shall be the Pohnpei Utility Corporation  
16 (PUC); the allottee of funds appropriated under  
17 subsection 4(2)(c) shall be the Office of Fisheries,  
18 Pohnpei State; the allottee of funds appropriated  
19 under subsection 4(2)(n) shall be the Secretary of  
20 the Department of Education or his designee; the  
21 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
22 4(3)(b) shall be the Governor of the State of Pohnpei  
23 or his designee; the allottee of funds appropriated  
24 under subsections 4(3)(c) and 4(3)(e) of this act  
25 shall be the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; allottee of

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1 funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(d) and  
2 4(3)(m) shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kittu. The  
3 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
4 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6) of this act shall be the Governor  
5 of Chuuk State or his designee. The allottee of  
6 funds appropriated under subsection 5(2) of this act  
7 shall be the Mortlock Islands Development Authority.  
8 The allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
9 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern Namoneas  
10 Development Authority. The allottee of funds  
11 appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act shall  
12 be the Faichuk Development Authority. The authority  
13 of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by  
14 this act shall lapse on September 30, 2018."

1       Section 5. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
2 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
3 becoming law without such approval.
