
AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 1-118 to provide full-year funding for the operations of the executive branch, national judiciary, Public Auditor, and other programs of the National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia during Fiscal Year 1981 by increasing the amount previously appropriated to \$2,229,000, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 1-118 is hereby amended to
2 read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$2,229,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of
5 the Federated States of Micronesia for the executive branch,
6 national judiciary, Public Auditor and other programs of the
7 National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia for
8 Fiscal Year 1981. The sum appropriated by this act shall be
9 apportioned as follows:

15	Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 1-118 is hereby amended to	
16	read as follows:	
17	"Section 2. The sums appropriated by this act shall be	
18	administered in accordance with the provisions of applicable	
19	law, including, but not limited to the Financial Management Act	
20	of 1979. The President or his designated allottee may reallocate	
21	up to 10 percent of line items in Subsection (1) and in Sub-	
22	section (4) of Section 1 of this act. The authority to obligate	
23	the funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of	
24	September 30, 1981."	
25	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President	

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1 of the Federated States of Micronesia, or upon its becoming law without
2 such approval.

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
