FIRST CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA Public Law No. 1-14/
THIRD SPECIAL SESSION, 1981 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 1-318, C.D.1, C.D.2

AN ACT

To declare the national policy on Sovereign Immunity and to provide for a limited waiver of immunity for specific types of claims, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Policy. Implicit in the sovereignty of a nation is the
- 2 right and power to determine whether, how, when and under what circum-
- 3 stances civil actions of any nature may be brought against it. The
- 4 Constitutional Convention determined that the National Government be
- 5 accountable for civil wrongs to its citizenry at such time and under such
- 6 terms and conditions as found appropriate from the national experience.
- 7 It is, therefore, at this time in our national history the policy of the
- 8 National Government of the Federated States of Micronesia to grant redress
- 9 for civil wrongs by waiving sovereign immunity to the extent prescribed
- 10 in this act.
- 11 Section 2. Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity. Actions upon the
- 12 following claims may be brought against the Federated States of Micronesia
- 13 with original and exclusive jurisdiction residing in the Trial Division of
- 14 the Supreme Court of the Federated States of Micronesia, and prior to its
- 15 organization, in the Trial Division of the High Court of the Trust Terri-
- 16 tory of the Pacific Islands:
- 17 (1) Claims for recovery of any tax alleged to have been
- 18 erroneously or illegally collected, or any penalty claimed to have been
- 19 collected without or beyond legal authorization, or any sum alleged to
- 20 have been excessive or improperly collected under applicable tax laws of
- 21 the Federated States of Micronesia.
- 22 (2) Claims for damages, injunction or mandamus arising out of

- 1 alleged improper administration of statutory laws of the Federated States
- of Micronesia, or any regulations issued pursuant to such statutory laws.
- 3 (3) Claims, whether liquidated or unliquidated, upon an express
- 4 or implied contract with the Federated States of Micronesia.
- 5 (4) Claims for injury or loss of property or personal injury or
- 6 death caused by the negligent or wrongful act or omission of an employee of
- 7 the National Government while acting within the scope of his office or
- 8 employment, under circumstances where the National Government, if a private
- 9 person, would be liable to the claimant in accordance with the law of the
- 10 place where the act or omission occurred. Recovery on an individual claim
- 11 as set out in this subsection shall not exceed \$20,000.
- 12 (5) Claims for any injuries suffered consequent upon conduct of
- 13 a National Government employee or agent acting under color of authority
- 14 which violates those individual rights secured under Article IV of the
- 15 Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia. Compensatory relief
- 16 granted for damages incurred from such violation shall not exceed \$20,000.
- 17 Section 3. Extent of Court's Jurisdiction. The jurisdiction of the
- 18 court shall extend to any set-off, affirmative defense, counterclaim or
- 19 other claim or demand whatever pleaded by the National Government of the
- 20 Federated States of Micronesia, or other properly joined party to such
- 21 action, against any plaintiff commencing an action under this act.
- 22 Section 4. Civil Actions by the National Government Not Limited.
- 23 Nothing in this act shall be construed as a limitation upon the right of
- 24 the Federated States of Micronesia to bring a civil action upon claims
- 25 of any nature. In any civil action brought by the Federated States of

1	Micronesia, the jurisdiction of the court shall extend to any set-off,
2	affirmative defense, counterclaim or other claim or demand whatever
3	pleaded by the named defendant or defendants, or other properly joined
4	party to such action, against the Federated States of Micronesia.
5	Section 5. Payment of Judgments. Money judgments rendered against
6	the Federated States of Micronesia pursuant to the provisions of this act
7	shall be paid from such funds as may be appropriated by the Congress of
8	the Federated States of Micronesia.
9	Section 6. Date of Accrual of Claims. Claims for which actions are
10	permitted against the Federated States of Micronesia under the provisions
11	of this act must accrue on or after the effective date of this act.
12	Section 7. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
13	of the Federated States of Micronesia, or upon its becoming law without
14	such approval.
