FIRST CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA PUBLIC LAW NO. 1-2, FIRST REGULAR SESSION, 1979 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 1-3, C.D.1, C.D.2

AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 6-109, to transfer authority over the Micronesian Washington Office to the Executive Branch of the Pederated States of Micronesia Government, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONCRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 6-109 is hereby amended 2 to read as follows: 3 "Section 1. There shall be an office to be known as the 'Micronesian Washington Office' to be located in Washington, 5 District of Columbia, United States of America, which shall be under the direct supervision of a Liaison Officer in accordance with the provisions of this act. The Liaison Officer shall be appointed by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, with the advice and consent of the 9 10 Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia. The Liaison Officer serves at the pleasure of the President." 11 12 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 6-109 is hereby amended 13 to read as follows: "Section 2. The Lisison Officer shall maintain the office 14 headquarters in Washington, D.C. and shall have the power 15 to employ such secretarial, clerical, technical, and 16 professional assistants as he may deem necessary to the 17 18 fulfilling of his duties and responsibilities, subject to 19 appropriations for his office. He shall represent the people of the Federated States of Micronesia on a full-time 20

basis before the Congress of the United States and before

the various departments and agencies of the Federal

1	Government and other organizations, public and private, on
2	all matters pertaining to the Federated States of Micronesia
3	and shall actively and fully advocate all programs and
4	policies duly adopted by the Government of the Federated
5	States of Micronesia. He shall not bind or commit the
6	Government of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands
7	without specific authority to do so. He shall also assist
8	the public officials of the Federated States of Micromesia
9	with respect to all matters necessary and pertaining to the
10	conduct of their offices, and shall render a report on his
11	activities in person to the Congress of the Federated States
12	of Micronesia every January beginning in 1980. He shall be
13	subject to the direction of the President of the Federated
14	States of Micronesia on the conduct of his office and shall
15	submit a monthly report of his activities to him."
16	Section 3. Section 3 of Public Law No. 6-109, as amended by
17	Public Law No. 7-65, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
18	"Section 3. The Liaison Officer shall be paid an annual
19	salary of \$24,000, which salary shall not be diminished
20	during his tenure of office. In addition thereto, he shall
21	receive an allowance each fiscal year for secretarial,
22	clerical, technical, and professional assistance, and for
23	all office expenses, including office rental and equipment,
24	and such other and further expenses as may be allowed by
25	the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia by

1	appropriation. The Liaison Officer and his family shall be
2	permitted one paid round trip from Washington to the Trust
3	Territory of the Pacific Islands every two years in addition
4	to his own travel on official business. He shall be
5	entitled to the same benefits as the members of the cabinet
6	of the President. For travel on official business he shall
7	be entitled to receive the standard Trust Territory Govern-
8	ment rates of per diem and actual travel costs."
9	Section 4. This act shall become law upon approval by the
10	President of the Federated States of Micronesia, or upon its becoming
11	law without such approval.
