Authorizing the Standing Committee on Resources and Development of the Congress of the Pederated States of Micronesia to assume the duties and responsibilities relating to the United Nations Development Programme.

- 2 exercised limison functions between the Interim Congress of the Federated
- 3 States of Micronesia and the United Nations Development Programme; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the United Nations Development Programme in Micronesia is
- 5 specifically concerned with economic planning and the development of
- 6 resources and the economy of Micronesia; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the jurisdiction of the Standing Committee on Resources and
- 8 Development specifically includes responsibility for economic planning,
- 9 priorities and policies, as well as for major areas of economic development,
- 10 including fisheries, agriculture, forestry, industries, utilities, communi-
- 11 cations, etc.; now, therefore,
- 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the First Congress of the Federated States of
- 13 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1979 that the Standing Committee on
- 14 Resources and Development of the Congress of the Federated States of
- 15 Micronesia is hereby authorized to assume all necessary duties and respon-
- 16 sibilities relating to the United Nations Development Programme in the
- 17 Federated States of Micronesia; and
