CONGRESSIONAL RESOLUTION NO. 1-39, CD1, CD2

A RESOLUTION

Relating to the transfer of executive functions from the Government of the Trust Territory to the Federated States of Micronesia.

- 1 WHEREAS, Secretarial Order No. 3039 provides for the transfer of executive
- 2 functions from the Government of the Trust Territory to the Federated States of
- 3 Micronesia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia allocates
- 5 government powers between the national and state governments; and
- 6 WHEREAS, executive functions performed by the Government of the Trust
- 7 Territory are within the scope of national and state powers as provided in the
- 8 Constitution; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the State-National Leaders Conference of the Federated States of
- 10 Micronesia, held in the State of Ponape, September 25 to September 27, 1979,
- 11 deliberated on the transfer of executive functions from the Government of the
- 12 Trust Territory to the Federated States of Micronesia and the performance of
- 13 such functions by national and state governments in a manner consistent with
- 14 the Constitution; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the State-National Leaders Conference established a consensus
- 16 on the transfer of certain executive functions from the Government of the
- 17 Trust Territory to the Federated States of Micronesia; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the consensus of the State-National Leaders Conference provides
- 19 that:
- 20 1. Agriculture research and development operations shall be
- 21 transferred to the national government and then to the state governments
- 22 upon request;

- 1 2. Transportation functions shall be transferred to the national
- 2 government and devolved to the state governments upon request;
- 3. The national government shall obtain and assign a government
- 4 vessel to the State of Kosrae to be operated by the national government until
- 5 devolved to the State Government of Kosrae;
- 6 4. The national government shall license air taxis and regulate
- 7 air transportation;
- 5. The state governments shall administer the physical grounds
- 9 and structures of airports and collect landing fees;
- 10 6. The state governments will be primarily responsible for
- 11 tourism and the national government will support and coordinate state tourism
- 12 activities:
- 7. Planning functions shall be transferred to the national
- 14 government which will provide technical assistance to the state governments;
- 8. Marine resources functions conducted by the Trust Territory
- 16 Government shall be transferred to the national government;
- 9. Coordination of United States federal programs functions shall
- 18 be transferred to the national government;
- 19 10. The Trust Territory Government should continue to fund and
- 20 operate the student and health services coordinator functions of the Trust
- 21 Territory Liaison Offices in Guam and Honolulu until the Federated States of
- 22 Micronesia can perform these functions;
- 23 11. The Office of the Student Services Coordinator should be
- 24 relocated to the University of Guam campus;
- 25 12. The Trust Territory Government should continue to operate the

- 1 Trust Territory San Francisco Office, performing recruitment and procurement
- 2 functions until the Federated States of Micronesia can perform these
- 3 functions;
- 4 13. Immigration functions shall be transferred to the national
- 5 government pursuant to national statute;
- 6 14. United States consuls shall be appointed to issue visas and
- 7 other travel documents within the states;
- 8 15. Training of government employees functions be transferred to
- 9 the national government; and
- 10 16. Information and broadcast functions conducted by the Trust
- 11 Territory Government be transferred to the national government; and
- 12 WHEREAS, this Congress concurs with the consensus established by the
- 13 State-National Leaders Conference and recognizes, as did the Conference,
- 14 that transfer of executive functions from the Government of the Trust Terri-
- 15 tory is not meaningful unless accompanied by the funds and property necessary
- 16 to perform those functions; now, therefore,
- 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the First Congress of the Federated States of Micro-
- 18 nesia, Second Regular Session, 1979, that the President of the Federated
- 19 States of Micronesia and the High Commissioner are requested to effectuate
- 20 as soon as feasible the transfer of executive functions and the funds and
- 21 property necessary to perform those functions consistent with the consensus
- 22 established by the State-National Leaders Conference of the Federated States
- 23 of Micronesia; and
- 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be
- 25 transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, the High
