THIRD REGULAR SESSION, 2020 CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 21-132, C.D.1

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-135, 20-146, 20-157, 20-179, 20-189, 21-06, 21-40 and 21-59, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of the states of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and for other purposes.

Public Law Nos. 20-135, 20-157, 20-179 and 21-40, is hereby further amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse 4 date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be 5 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in 6 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not 7 8 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these 9 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used 10 11 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum 12 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated 13 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap 14 State or his designee. The allottee of the funds 15 16 appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or 17 his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds 18 appropriated under subsection 3(o) of this act shall be 19 the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee, the 20 allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(b) to 21 3(q) and 3(u) to 3(z) of this act shall be the Mayor of 22 Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of 23 funds appropriated under subsections 3(a), 3(r), 3(s)24 and 3(t) of this act shall be the Mayor of Tafunsak 25

Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-125, as amended by

Municipal Government or his designee; the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsection $4(1)(v)$ of this act
shall be the Meninkeder lapalap of Madolenihmw Municipal
Government or his designee; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection 4(1)(w) of this act shall
be the Chief Minister of U Municipal Government or his
designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 4(1)(x) of this act shall be the District
Administrator of Nett Municipal Government or his
designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 4(1)(y) of this act shall be the Luhken
Menlap of Kitti Municipal Government or his designee;
the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections
4(2)(w) and $4(1)(z)$ of this act shall be the Chief
Magistrate of Sokehs Municipal Government or his
designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under
subsections $4(2)(a)$ to $4(2)(v)$ of this act shall be the
Secretary of the Department of Transportation,
Communications and Infrastructure or his designee; the
allottee of fund appropriated under subsections 4(1)(a2)
and 4(4)(m) of this act shall be the Mayor of Pingelap
Municipal Government; the allottee of funds appropriated
under subsections 4(1)(al) and 4(4)(n) of this act shall
be the Chief Magistrate of Mwoakilloa Municipal
Government; the allottee of funds appropriated under

1	subsection 4(1)(a3) of this act shall be the Luhken
2	Kolwof of Sapuwafik Municipal Government; the allottee
3	of funds appropriated under subsection 4(1)(a4) of this
4	act shall be the Mayor of Nukuoro Municipal Government;
5	the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
6	4(1)(a5) of this act shall be the Chief Magistrate of
7	Kapingamarangi Municipal Government. The allottee of
8	funds appropriated under subsection 4(4)(b) of this act
9	shall be the Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA). The
10	allottee of the funds appropriated sections 5 of this
11	act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his
12	designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of funds
13	appropriated under subsections 5(h) and 5(j) of this act
14	shall be the FSM Telecommunication Corporation or its
15	designee. The authority of the allottee to obligate
16	funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September
17	30, 2021".
