
I am pleased to transmit the following Congressional Act, which I sign to become Public Law No.21-36:

Congressional Act No. 21-10, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 20-178, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 20-01 AND 21-07, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 4,5 AND 6 THEREOF TO CHANGE THE USE AND ALLOTTEE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF POHNPEI AND CHUUK STATES, AND POHNPEI, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

Based on the FSM Department of Justice's review, section 6 of the Act amends that the allottee of funds previously appropriated under subsection 4(1)(t) for Pohnpei State At-Large shall be the Vice President of the Federated States of Micronesia or his designee and the Governor of the Pohnpei State or his designee. If this is an error, I recommend that you rectify it and resubmit the Act for the Executive Branch's Action.

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-01 and 21-07, by amending sections 4, 5 and 6 thereof to change the use and allottee of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Pohnpei and Chuuk states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

6 Section 3. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-178, as amended by  
7 Public Law No. 21-01, is hereby amended to read as  
8 follows:

9 "Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and  
10 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be  
11 allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in  
12 accordance with applicable laws, including, but not  
13 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The  
14 allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these  
15 funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used  
16 solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that  
17 no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum  
18 appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated  
19 under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap  
20 State or his designee. The allottee of funds  
21 appropriated under section 3 of this act shall be the  
22 Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT  
23 the allottee of funds appropriated under subsections  
24 3(ad) of this act and 4(2)(q) shall be the President of  
25 COM-FSM or his designee; the allottee of funds

 23          funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(g) and 4(4)(f)  
 24          of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation  
 25          Authority, the funds appropriated under subsections

1           4(3)(i) and 4(3)(j) of this act shall be the Secretary  
2           of the Department of Transportation, Communications and  
3           Infrastructure or his designee; The allottee of the  
4           funds appropriated under subsections 5(1), 5(3) and 5(6)  
5           of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his  
6           designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
7           subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks  
8           Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the  
9           funds appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act  
10          shall be the Southern Namoneas Development Authority;  
11          the allottee of the funds appropriated under subsection  
12          5(5) of this act shall be the Faichuk Development  
13          Authority. The authority of the allottee to obligate  
14          funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on September  
15          30, 2020."


