RATIFYING THE SMALL QUANTITIES PROTOCOL AS A TREATY BETWEEN THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA AND THE INTERNATIONAL ATOMIC ENERGY AGENCY IN CONNECTION WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS UNDER THE TREATY ON THE NON-PROLIFERATION OF NUCLEAR WEAPONS.

## A RESOLUTION

Ratifying the Small Quantities Protocol as a Treaty Between the Federated States of Micronesia and the International Atomic Energy Agency in connection with the implementation and reporting requirements under the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons.

- 1 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia is a State
- 2 Party to the Treaty on the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons
- 3 as of April 14, 1995; and
- WHEREAS, the Treaty is founded on three key pillars,
- 5 namely: (a) Safeguards, (b) Peaceful Uses of Nuclear Energy,
- 6 and (c) Nuclear Disarmament; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Treaty also requires States Parties to
- 8 negotiate, enter into, and conclude the Safeguards Agreement in
- 9 accordance with the Statute of the International Atomic Energy
- 10 Agency (IAEA); and
- WHEREAS, pursuant to this legal obligation in the Treaty,
- 12 the FSM and the IAEA concluded the Safeguards Agreement by
- 13 their signatures on April 21, 2015, in Palikir, Pohnpei, and on
- 14 June 1, 2015, in Vienna, Austria, respectively; and
- WHEREAS, in addition to concluding the Safeguards
- 16 Agreement, the FSM has the option to conclude a Small
- 17 Quantities Protocol (SQP) with the IAEA, which essential allows
- 18 the FSM to hold the implementation of certain provisions of
- 19 Part II of the Safeguards Agreement in abeyance until such time

- 1 that the FSM either comes into possession of nuclear materials
- 2 for peaceful activities in quantities exceeding the limits
- 3 established in Article 36 of the Safeguards Agreement, or the
- 4 FSM decides to construct or allow to be constructed a
- 5 "facility," which the Safeguards Agreement defines as "(a) a
- 6 reactor, a critical facility, a conversion plant, a fabrication
- 7 plant, a reprocessing plant, an isotope separation plant or a
- 8 separate storage installation; or (b) any location where
- 9 nuclear material in amounts greater than one effective kilogram
- 10 is customarily used"; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the conclusion of the SQP brings practical
- 12 advantages to the FSM since it relieves itself from the burdens
- 13 of the full application of Part II of the Safeguards
- 14 Agreements; and
- WHEREAS, the SQP requires ratification by the FSM Congress
- 16 as a treaty; now, therefore,
- 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Twenty-Second Congress of the
- 18 Federated States of Micronesia, First Regular Session, 2021,
- 19 that Congress hereby ratifies the Small Quantities Protocol as
- 20 a Treaty Between the Federated States of Micronesia and the
- 21 International Atomic Energy Agency in connection with the
- 22 implementation and reporting requirements under the Treaty on
- 23 the Non-Proliferation of Nuclear Weapons; and

4	Foreign Affairs and the Secretary of the Department of Justice.
