Dear Speaker Simina:

I am transmitting the following act, which I have signed to become Public Law No. <u>22–123</u> with item veto for the reasons stated in this transmittal:

Congressional Act No. 22-119, entitled: "AN ACT TO FURTHER AMEND PUBLIC LAW NO. 21-43, AS AMENDED BY PUBLIC LAWS NOS. 21-54, 21-71, 21-82, 21-103, 21-107, 21-158, 21-186, 21-235, 22-16, 22-50 AND 22-68, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 5 AND 6 THEREOF, TO CHANGE THE LAPSE DATE OF FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED THEREIN, TO FUND PUBLIC PROJECTS AND SOCIAL PROGRAMS FOR THE PEOPLE OF YAP, KOSRAE, POHNPEI AND CHUUK STATES, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

The extension of the lapse date is in order. But with respect to the change of use of funds, in particular, section 5(6)(g), for POL/Charters/Freight in the amount of \$60,000, according to records in the Department of Finance & Administration, there is insufficient funds under this appropriation. Hence, it is with regret that I item veto this particular item.



#### AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-54, 21-71, 21-82, 21-103, 21-107, 21-158, 21-186, 21-235, 22-16, 22-50 and 22-68, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Yap, Kosrae, Pohnpei and Chuuk States, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1	Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 21-43, as amended
2	by Public Law No. 21-54, 21-82, 21-107, 21-158, 21-186, 22-16 and
3	22-68, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

14	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 21-43, as
15	amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-54, 21-71, 21-107, 21-158 and
16	21-235, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
17	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse
18	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
19	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in
20	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not
21	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The
22	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these
23	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used
24	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that no
25	obligations are incurred in excess of the sum

appropriated. The allottee of the funds appropriated
under section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap
State or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsection 2(f) of this act shall
be the President of the COM-FSM Institute. The allottee
of funds appropriated under sections 3 and 4 of this act
shall be the President of the Federated States of
Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT, the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsection 3(1) of this act shall
be the Governor of Kosrae State or his designee; the
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 3(2) of
this act shall be the Mayor of Lelu Town Government or his
designee. The allottee of funds appropriated under
section $4(1)$ and $4(3)(1)$ of this act shall be the Vice
President; The allottee of funds appropriated under
subsection 4(1)(a) of this act shall be the Secretary of
the Department of Transportation, Communications and
Infrastructure or his designee, except that the allottee
of funds appropriated under subsections $4(2)(e)$ , $4(4)(j)$ ,
4(4)(k), $4(4)(1)$ and $4(4)(m)$ of this act shall be the
Pohnpei Transportation Authority (PTA); the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsections $4(2)(1)$ , $4(3)(d)$ and
4(3)(f) of this act shall be the Secretary of the
Department of Education or his designee; the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsection 4(2)(h) of this act

shall be the President of COM-FSM; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection $4(2)(m)$ of this act shall be
the Mayor of Nukuoro Municipal Government or his designee;
the allottee of funds appropriated under subsection
4(2)(j) of this act shall be the Secretary of the FSM
Department of Resources and Development; the allottee of
funds appropriated under subsections 4(3)(a), 4(3)(b),
4(3)(e), $4(3)(h)$ , $4(3)(i)$ and $4(3)(k)$ of this act shall be
the Meninkeder of Madolenihmw; the allottee of funds
appropriated under subsection $4(3)(c)$ of this act shall be
the Chief Justice of Madolenihmw Municipal Government; the
allottee of funds appropriated under subsection $4(3)(g)$ of
this act shall be the Luhkenmoanlap of Kitti; the allottee
of funds appropriated under subsection $4(3)(j)$ of this act
shall be the Speaker of Isokonedi of Kitti; the allottee
of funds appropriated under subsection $4(3)(m)$ of this act
shall be the Director of Pohnpei Public Safety. The
allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 5(1) and
5(6) of this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or
his designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under
subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks Island
Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of the funds
appropriated under subsection 5(4) of this act shall be
the Southern Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee
of the funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this

1	act shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The
2	allottee of funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of
3	this act shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government
4	or his designee. The authority of the allottee to
5	obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse on
6	September 30, 2024."
7	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
8	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its
9	becoming law without such approval.
