AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 21-54, 21-71, 21-82, 21-103, 21-107, 21-158, 21-186 and 21-235, by amending section 5 thereof, to change the use of certain funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs for the people of Chuuk State, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 21-43, as amended by  
2 Public Law No. 21-54, 21-82, 21-107, 21-158 and 21-186, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

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
