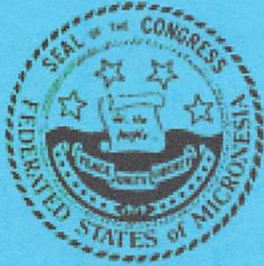

AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 20-60, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75, 20-85, 20-97, 20-150, 21-69, 21-84, 21-100, 21-129, 21-163, 21-173, 21-187, 22-11, 22-59 and 22-78, by amending sections 5 and 6 thereof, to change the use and extend the lapse date of funds previously appropriated therein, to fund public projects and social programs in each of the states, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 20-60, as amended  
2    by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-85, 20-150, 21-60, 21-84, 22-11  
3    and 22-59, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

4           "Section 5. Of the \$4,450,000 appropriated under this  
5           act, \$1,800,000 shall be apportioned for public projects  
6           and social programs in the state of Chuuk.

13	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 20-60, as amended	
14	by Public Laws Nos. 20-65, 20-75, 20-97, 21-129, 21-163, 21-173 and	
15	22-78 is hereby further amended to read as follows:	
16	"Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and lapse	
17	date. All funds appropriated by this act shall be	
18	allotted, managed, administered and accounted for in	
19	accordance with applicable laws, including, but not	
20	limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The	
21	allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these	
22	funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used	
23	solely for the purpose specified in this act, and that	
24	no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum	
25	appropriated. The allottee of funds appropriated under	


1           section 2 of this act shall be the Governor of Yap State  
2           or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the allottee of funds  
3           appropriated under subsections 2(i), 2(j) and 2(n) of  
4           this act shall be the President or his designee. The  
5           allottee of the funds appropriated under sections 3 and  
6           4 of this act shall be the President of the Federated  
7           States of Micronesia or his designee; PROVIDED THAT the  
8           allottee of funds appropriated under subsections 3(a) to  
9           3(o) and subsection 3(af) of this act shall be the Mayor  
10          of Lelu Town Government or his designee; the allottee of  
11          funds appropriated under subsections 3(p) to 3(ae) of  
12          this act shall be the Governor of Kosrae State or his  
13          designee; the allottee of funds appropriated under  
14          subsections 4(1)(m) and 4(1)(o) of this act shall be the  
15          Mayor of Pingelap or his designee; the allottee of funds  
16          appropriated under subsections 4(2)(e), 4(2)(g) and  
17          4(2)(m) of this act shall be the Pohnpei Transportation  
18          Authority (PTA); the allottee of funds appropriated  
19          under subsection 4(2)(o) of this act shall be the  
20          Pohnpei Utility Corporation (PUC). The allottee of the  
21          funds appropriated under subsections 5(1) and 5(6) of  
22          this act shall be the Governor of Chuuk State or his  
23          designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
24          subsection 5(2) of this act shall be the Mortlocks  
25          Island Development Authority (MIDA); the allottee of



1 funds appropriated under subsection 5(3) of this act  
2 shall be the Mayor of Weno Municipal Government or his  
3 designee; the allottee of the funds appropriated under  
4 subsection 5(4) of this act shall be the Southern  
5 Namoneas Development Authority; the allottee of the  
6 funds appropriated under subsection 5(5) of this act  
7 shall be the Faichuk Development Authority. The  
8 authority of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated  
9 by this act shall lapse on September 30, 2024."

10 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the  
11 President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
12 becoming law without such approval.
