A BILL FOR AN ACT

To establish a Mational Sports Commission to encourage sports activities between encourage participation of the Federated States of Micronesia the States and in regional and international sports organizations and events; to appropriate the sum of \$50,000 for the formation and operation of the Commission; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Policy and purpose. The participation by the people of the
- Federated States of Micronesia in sports events and sports associations on an
- interstate, regional, and international level is a great learning opportunity
- for the participants. Active involvement in sports activities helps to promote
- the good health of our people. By increasing the awareness of the people of the
- Federated States of Micronesia of sports organizations and events, participation
- in these activities and events will be increased. Further, participation in
- friendly sports competition between residents of our States as well as between
- representatives of our Nation and other nations will help promote fellowship and
- unity for our Nation and recognition by other nations.
- Section 2. Creation of Commission and membership. There shall be established 11
- a National Sports Commission (hereinafter the "Commission") which shall consist of
- five members (hereinafter commissioners). The Speaker of the Congress of the 13
- Federated States of Micronesia, after consultation with the Governor and Speaker
- of the legislature of each State, shall appoint one commissioner from each State.
- The Speaker of the Congress shall also appoint one Member of Congress after consulta-16
- tion with the Members of Congress. The commissioners shall elect a chairperson by 17
- a majority vote. 18
- Section 3. Duties of the Commission. The Commission shall do the following: 19
- (1) Hire an executive director, possessing such qualifications as 20
- may be established by the Commission, to run the day to day affairs of the 21
- 22 Commission;
- Meet quarterly to: 23
- (a) Set general policy and guidelines; and 24
- (b) Evaluate for approval or disapproval funding proposals 25

- 7 (4) Establish, in conjunction with State sports associations, and

- 10 (5) Sanction the amateur status of Federated States of Micronesia
- 11 athletics;
- 12 (6) Promote and supervise interstate athletic competition within the
- 13 Federated States of Micronesia;
- 14 (7) Promote the construction, and where appropriate, the standardization
- 19 8 sports facilities in the federated States of Micronesia;
- 16 (8) Maintain the official sports records of the Federated States of
- 17 Micronesia; and
- 18 (9) Seek funds from public and private sources for the performance of
- 19 its duties.
- 20 Section 4. Duties of the executive director. The executive director shall
- 21 do the following:
- 22 (1) Establish contacts with local, regional, and international sports
- 23 associations, federations, and committees;
- 24 (2) Compile and maintain ongoing communications with the groups listed
- 25 in subsection 1 of this section;

- (3) Establish and keep a calendar of upcoming sporting events and 1 meetings;
- (4) Establish a mailing list of persons of organizations interested 3
- in receiving this calend r of events and provide copies of the calender to the
- on the mailing list;
- (5) Compile an agenda for the Commission's quarterly meeting includi-
- all funding requests received; and
- 8 (6) Perform such other duties as the commissioners may require pursuant
- 9 to the provisions of this act.
- 10 Section 5. Compensation. Members of the Commission, excluding those who
- are members of a State government or the National Government, shall be compensate 11
- at the rate of \$35 per day when actually on the business of the Commission. All 12
- 13 members of the Commission shall receive per diem and travel expenses at established
- Federated States of Micronesia Government rates while on the business of the Com-14

- Section 6. Appropriation. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may be 16
- necessary, is appropriated from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micro-17
- nesia for the purposes set forth in section 3 of this act. 18
- Section 7. Financial Management. All funds appropriated by this act shall 19
- 20 be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
- law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979. The 21
- allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof 22
- 23 as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in this act, and
- that no obligations are incurred in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority 24
- of the allottee to obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of 25
