A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to article IX, section 12, of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia to provide that the runner-up candidate receiving the next highest vote total fill the vacancies in the Congress created by the selection of a President and Vice President.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:	
ì	Section 1. Proposed amendment. It is hereby proposed that article	
2	IX, section 12, of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia	
3	be amended to read as follows:	
4	"Section 12. A vacancy in Congress is filled for the unexpired	
5	term. In the absence of provision by law, an unexpired term	
6	is filled by special election, except that:	
7	a) An unexpired term of less than one year is filled	
8	by appointment by the state chief executive/; or	
9	b) Vacancies created by the selection of a President	
10	and Vice-President shall be filled by the candidate who received	
11	the next highest vote total for the four-year term, from the	
12	state of the new President and Vice-President."	
13	Section 2. <u>Procedure</u> . Upon this act becoming law, the proposed	
14	4 constitutional amendment set out in section 1 will become part of the	
15	5 Constitution after completion of procedures and ratification as required	
16	6 by Public Law No. 2-51.	
17	Section 3. Effective date. This act shall become law upon approval	
18	by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming	
19	law without such approval.
