A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend sections 1 and 2 of Public Law No. 2-34, as amended by Public Law No. 2-44, appropriating the sum of \$846,200 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of funding certain public projects in the State of Truk, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Public Law No. 2-34, as amended by Public

2 Law No. 2-44, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 1. The sum of \$846,200, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund
5 of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year
6 ending September 30, 1982, for the purpose of funding certain
7 public projects in the State of Truk. The sum appropriated
8 by this section shall be apportioned as follows:

12 Section 2. Section 2 of Public Law No. 2-34 relating to making
13 the Faichuk chief magistrates allottees for all Faichuk public projects
14 is hereby repealed in its entirety. Section 2 of Public Law No. 2-34
15 relating to the applicability of the Financial Management Act of 1979
16 is left intact and remains as the only section 2 of Public Law No. 2-34.

17 Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the President
18 of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming law without
19 such approval.
