A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend sections 311, 331, and 334 of Public Law No. 2-54 allowing persons 16 years of age or older to vote in the plebiscite and removing the disenfranchisement from those convicted of a criminal offense, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICROMESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 311 of Public Law No. 2-54 is hereby amended
- 2 to read as follows:

- 3 "Section 311. Eligible voters. Every citizen of the 4 Federated States of Micronesia is eligible to vote in the 5 plebiscite, if he has fulfilled the following requirements:
- 6 (1) Be 18 16 years of age or older on the day of the 7 plebiscite;
- 8 (2) Be a resident or domiciliary of the State of Kosrae, Ponape, Truk, or Yap and a registered voter therein; and 9
- 10 (3) Is not currently under a judgment of mental incompetency or insanity. And 11
- ea) is not enticated under parole/probation/ of sentence 12 tot and telony tot which he had been convicted by any court of 13 the redetated states of victoresia, the trust tertitoty, of any 14 equite within the jutisdiction of the united statesi" 15
- Section 2. Section 331 of Public Law No. 2-54 is hereby amended 16 17 to read as follows:
- "Section 331. Eligibility to register; Place of registering 18 19 and voting.
 - (1) Any person who is a citizen of the Federated States of Micronesia, who has reached the age of 18 16 years or will have reached the age of 16 years on or before the date of the plebiscite, who has resided in the Federated States of Micronesia for nine months and in the State of registration three months preceding the date of registration, and who,

1	except for the requirement of registration, is otherwise
2	eligible to vote in the plebiscite, may register to vote
3	in the State in which he resides.
4	(2) The plebiscite commissioner of each State shall
5	designate such place or places within the State wherein
6	registration of voters may be made.
7	(3) No person shall register to vote or vote in any
8	other State than that in which he resides; PROVIDED that
9	where there is a mistake in placing the name of the voter
10	in the State plebiscite register of a State in which he
11	does not actually reside, such voter shall nevertheless be
12	allowed to vote therein, if otherwise qualified; and the
13	plebiscite board of the State where such voter has voted
14	shall notify the plebiscite commissioner of the other
15	State of the error.
16	(4) If any person resides in more than one State he
17	shall register as a voter of one State only."
18	Section 3. Section 334 of Public Law No. 2-54 is hereby amended to
19	read as follows:
20	"Section 334. Application for registration; Affidavit.
21	(1) Any person eligible to and desiring to register
22	as a voter may present himself any time during business
23	hours to any of the members of the plebiscite board (herein
24	empowered and authorized to administer oaths and take
25	acknowledgements) or persons authorized by law or tegrilations
