A RESOLUTION

Requesting the Office of the Attorney General of the Federated States of Micronesia to assign a well trained and experienced investigator to the State of Yap to investigate major crimes as well as to help the Yap State police investigate other crimes.

- 1 WHEREAS, the State of Yap is the farthest State from the Capital
- 2 of the Federated States of Micronesia; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the State of Yap is wanting in well trained and
- 4 experienced investigators; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in the past years some major crimes have been committed
- 6 with impunity due to this shortage of well trained and
- 7 experienced investigators; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the State of Yap is presently unable to recruit a
- 9 well trained and experienced investigator; and
- 10 WHEREAS, there are relatively well trained and experienced
- 11 investigators working for the National Government; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the State of Yap is enforcing the National Criminal
- 13 Code for the Federated States of Micronesia; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the National Government should assist the State of
- 15 Yap and other States in enforcing the National Criminal Code; now,
- 16 therefore,
- 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of
- 18 Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress hereby
- 19 requests the Office of the Attorney General to assign a well trained
- 20 and experienced investigator to the State of Yap to investigate
- 21 major crimes as well as to help the Yap State police investigate
- 22 other crimes; and
