_ A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting officials of the United States Government and the United States Congress to expedite the appropriation of funds authorized for the College of Micronesia as a result of its designation as a land-grant college.

- 1 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia was designated a land-grant
- 2 college by the United States Higher Education Act of 1980 (United
- 3 States Public Law No. 96-374); and
- WHEREAS, in lieu of the College of Micronesia receiving federal
- 5 land from the United States Government as have other land-grant colleges,
- 6 the United States Congress in said law authorized an appropriation of
- 7 \$3 million to be placed in a trust fund as an endowment for the College
- 8 of Micronesia, with the interest from such trust fund to be available to
- 9 the College of Micronesia for its various programs and projects related
- 10 to agriculture and other permitted fields of study; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia has entered into a Memorandum
- 12 of Understanding with the United States Department of Agriculture regard-
- 13 ing extension services in agriculture and home economics in Micronesia
- 14 pursuant to the Smith-Lever Act and other applicable laws; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia Cooperative Extension Service
- 16 has entered into a Project Agreement with the Extension Service of the
- 17 United States Department of Agriculture regarding the organization and
- 18 administration of the Cooperative Extension Program pursuant to the
- 19 Smith-Lever Act and other applicable laws; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia has established an Agricultural
- 21 Experiment Station; and
- 22 WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia has established a College of
- 23 Tropical Agriculture and Sciences; and
- 24 WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Third Congress of the Federated
- 25 States of Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1983, that the College of
