A RESOLUTION

Ratifying the United Vations Convention on the Law of the Sea.

- UNEPEAS, the United Mations Convention on the Law of the Sea was
- concluded and opened for signature at Montego Bay, Jamaica, on
- December 10, 1982: and
- WHILFEAS, in 1975 the Congress of Micronesia established the
- Delegation of Micronesia to represent the interests of the people of
- Micronesia at the Third United Nations Conference on the Law of the
- Sea, which delegation was a fully participating Observer Member of the 7
- Conference: and
- MHEREAS, in 1979 the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia
- established a Joint Delegation of the Federated States of Micronesia to the
- Conference as a successor delegation to the Delegation of Micronesia 1.1.
- established by the Congress of Micronesia, and which also was a fully 12
- participating Observer Member of the Conference and
- WHEREAS, the Third United Mations Conference on the Law of the 14
- Sea was the international forum responsible for the formulation and
- drafting of the United Nations Convention on the Low of the Sea: and
- WHEREAS, the United Nations Convention on the Law. of the Sea is 17
- an international agreement requiring ratification by the Congress in
- accordance with article IX, section 4, of the Constitution of the 19
- Federated States of Micronesia and 20
- IMEREAS, the Tederated States of Micronesia is competent to become 21
- a Party to the Convention pursuant to article 305(1)(d)(e) of the 22
- 23 Convention: and
- MMEREAS, in addition to ratification by Congress, participation 24
- in the Convention will require signature or the deposit of an instrument

of accession by the executive branch; and WHEREAS, certain obstacles to FSM participation in the Convention have been raised by forces external to the Federated States of Micronesia, obstacles which may delay FSM participation in the Convention for a period of time; and 5 WHEREAS, nevertheless it is desirable to complete the congressional act of ratification of the Convention, so that the executive branch can proceed with an expedited signature or accession at the appropriate time; and WHEREAS, by letter dated October 28, 1983, addressed to the Speaker 10 11 of the Congress, the President of the Federated States of Micronesia recommended ratification of the Convention; now, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED by the Third Congress of the Federated States of 14 Micronesia, Second Regular Session, 1983, that the Congress hereby 15 ratifies the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea concluded 16 at Montego Bay, Jamaica, on December 10, 1982; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia, 18 the Secretary of the United States Department of State, and the High 19 Commissioner of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands. 21 Date: 10/31/83 Introduced by: (by request) 23 24
