	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA
1	Section 1. Title 4 of the Code of the Federated States of
2	Micronesia, as amended by Public Law No. 3-3, is hereby further
3	amended by adding a new section 126 to read as follows:
4	"Section 126. Judiciary Account.
5	(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 2,
6	title 55 of the Code of the Federated States of
7	Micronesia and regulations promulgated thereunder to the
8	contrary, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court or his
9	designee may, from time to time, request that the
LO	Secretary of Finance transfer funds appropriated in the
11	judiciary budget for "Others" into a separate judiciary
L2	bank account. The Secretary of Finance shall promptly
13	deposit the funds as requested; PROVIDED that the total
L4	balance in the judiciary account shall at no time exceed
15	\$30,000.
16	(2) Funds from the judiciary account shall be
_7	expended only upon the signature of the Chief Justice or,
18	in his absence, his authorized designee. The judiciary
.9	account shall be used only for payments and procurement
20	of supplies and materials authorized under the "Others"
21	category of the judiciary budget, subject to the
22	discretion and authority of the Chief Justice or his
23	designee to solely administer, manage, and control all
