A BILL FOR AN ACT

To establish a Vocational Agriculture Grant Program; to authorize promulgation of regulations for the administration of the program; and for other purposes.

| 1 | Section 1. <u>Title</u> . This act shall be known as the "Vocational |
| 2 | Agriculture Grant Program Act." |
| 3 | Section 2. Eligibility. Public and private nonprofit |
| 4 | educational organizations, institutions, and agencies in the |
| 5 | Federated States of Micronesia are eligible to apply for grants |
| 6 | under the program. |
| 7 | Section 3. <u>Selection</u> . A selection committee, composed of the |
| 8 | Chief of the Division of Training, Office of Personnel; the Chief |
| 9 | of the Division of Agriculture, Department of Resources and |
| 10 | Development; and the Program Development Coordinator, Division of |
| 11 | Education, Department of Social Services shall review each |
| 12 | application and recommend its approval or disapproval to the Chief |
| 13 | of the Division of Education of the Federated States of Micronesia, |
| 14 | who will either approve or disapprove the application. |
| 15 | Section 4. <u>Utilization of funds</u> . Funds appropriated by |
| 16 | Congress from the General Fund of the Federated States of |
| 17 | Micronesia for grants under the program shall be used for |
| 18 | education, research, and development in the fields of agriculture, |
| 19 | animal husbandry, aquaculture, and forestry. |
| 20 | Section 5. Reporting. The Chief of the Division of Education |
| 21 | of the Federated States of Micronesia shall prepare and submit an |
| 22 | annual report on the status of the program prior to the |
| 23 | commencement of each regular May session of Congress. This report |
| 24 | shall detail the expenditures of program funds during the preceding |
| 25 | fiscal year, and shall include such other information as the Chief |

of the Division of Education of the Federated States of Micronesia 2 may deem to be appropriate. Section 6. Promulgation of regulations. The Chief of the 3 4 Division of Education of the Federated States of Micronesia, with 5 the approval of the President, shall promulgate regulations, pursuant to chapter 1 of title 17 of the Code of the Federated 6 7 States of Micronesia, governing the process of applying for grants under the program; the process of selecting recipients of grants 8 9 under the program; the criteria for awarding grants under the 10 program; the means of monitoring and evaluating grants under the 11 program; and such other matters as may be consistent with the 12 contents and purposes of this act. This act shall become law upon 13 Section 7.
