A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 4-11 by amending sections 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, and 9 for the purpose of appropriating the sum of \$3,788,210 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia and the sum of \$135,858 from the United States Grant Special Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1986, as supplemental funding for the operations of the executive branch, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, contributions, grants, and subsidies of the National Government during fiscal year 1986; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979, as amended. Each allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purposes specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of 25 percent of that no eduliphent of that no eduliphent of \$50 may be purposed and no new positions while the ether? The authority of the allottees to obligate funds appropriated by this act, except those appropriated by section 5(5) shall lapse as of September 30, 1986. The 25 percent restriction on obligations shall not be applicable to the sums appropriated while section 5 (5) shall lapse as of
