## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend section 2 of Public Law No. 4-41 for the purpose of requiring the licensing of pharmacists, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-41 is hereby amended 2 to read as follows: 3 "Section 2. Definitions. As used herein unless otherwise indicated by the context: 4 (1) 'Board' means the Federated States of Micronesia 5 Medical Health Care Licensing Board. 7 (2) 'Practice of medical health care' includes 8 activities as a doctor, nurse, optometrist of, dentist or pharmacist, as those activities may be described by the 9 President or the Board pursuant to this act or amendments 10 11 (3) 'President' means the President of the Federated 12 States of Micronesia." 13 14 Section 2. Section 5 of Public Law No. 4-41 is hereby amended 15 to read as follows: "Section 5. Authority to promulgate regulations; Fees. 16 (1) The President is authorized to promulgate 17 regulations, pursuant to chapter 1 of title 17 of the Code 18 of the Federated States of Micronesia, to carry into effect 19 this act. He may delegate this authority to the Board. 20 21 (2) Any regulations under this act shall include a definition of the term 'practice of medical health care' 22 which shall include activities as a doctor, nurse, 23

optometrist of, dentist or pharmacist. Such definition

1	(a) Be a reasonable approximation of the
2	ordinary understanding of the activities of doctors,
3	nurses, optometrists and, dentists, and pharmacists;
4	(b) Exempt students participating in a directly
5	controlled program of medical study; and
6	(c) Exempt licensed doctors, nurses,
7	optometrists and, dentists and pharmacists from such other
8	jurisdictions as may be prescribed by regulation who are in
9	the FSM on consultations and registered with and approved
10	by the Board.
11	(3) The Board may by regulation require that a fee be
12	paid by applicants for licenses or renewals of licenses.
13	The fees may be different for different types of licenses.
14	In no event shall any fee be greater than \$400."
15	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
16	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
17	law without such approval.
