A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 3-24, 4-63, 4-65 and 4-75, by adding a new section 106 to provide for an interim acting President in the event that Congress does not elect a President or Vice-President, pursuant to sections 1 and 5 of article X of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia, prior to the expiration of the terms of the outgoing President and Vice-President, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. Title 2 of the Code of the Federated States of
- 2 Micronesia is hereby further amended by adding a new section 106 to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "Section 106. Interim acting President.
- (1) If the Congress has not elected a President or

 Vice-President, pursuant to sections 1 and 5 of article X

 of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia,

 prior to the expiration of the terms of an outgoing

 President and Vice-President, then the Secretary of
- External Affairs, or, if he is unable to serve, the

 Secretary of Finance, shall serve in an interim capacity as
- acting President until Congress elects a President or Vice-

- 14 (2) In the event that, while serving in an interim
- 15 capacity as acting President, the Secretary of External
- Affairs or the Secretary of Finance is required to submit
- his resignation as Secretary pursuant to subsection (4) of
- section 207 of title 2 of this Code, as established by
- Public Law No. 3-24, such resignation shall not affect his
- 20 capacity to serve as acting President. He shall also
- 21 continue to receive his former compensation and benefits
- 22 while serving as acting President."
