A RESOLUTION

Requesting the Micronesian Maritime Authority to negotiate with all owners of purse seiners operating within the jurisdiction of the Federated States of Micronesia for the purpose of establishing agreements regarding the disposal of incidental fish catches.

- WHEREAS, purse seiners operate within the jurisdiction of the 1
- Federated States of Micronesia; and 2
- WHEREAS, purse seining involves the incidental taking of undersized 3
- tuna and other fish which are considered undesirable by the operators of
- purse seiners; and
- WHEREAS, these fish have, up to this time, apparently been discarded
- by the operators of purse seiners, with no effort made to ensure produc-
- tive use of the incidental catches; and
- WHEREAS, these fish could be delivered to inhabited islands or State 9
- centers where they would not be wasted; and 10
- WHEREAS, fishing agreements already include the provision that 11
- turtles are to be released and the Congress of the Federated States of
- Micronesia believes that marine mammals should also be released; now, therefore, 13
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Fourth Congress of the Federated States of 14
- Micronesia, First Regular Session, 1985, that the Micronesian Maritime 15
- Authority is hereby requested to negotiate with all owners of purse seiners
- operating within the jurisdiction of the Federated States of Micronesia 17
- for the purpose of establishing agreements whereby purse seiners will 18
- deliver their incidental catches, other than turtles and marine mammals, 19
- to nearby inhabited islands or State centers; and 20
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this resolution 21
- be transmitted to the Chairman and the Executive Director of the 22
- Micronesian Maritime Authority. 23
