CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 5-281, C.D.1

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$192,655 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1989, for the purpose of funding the purchase of a computer system, including hardware and software, for the National Government Financial Management System, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. The sum of \$192,655, or so much thereof as may be
- 2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
- 4 30, 1989, for the purpose of funding the purchase of a computer
- 5 system, including hardware and software, for the National Government
- 6 Financial Management System.
- 7 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
- 8 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with
- 9 applicable law, including, but not limited to, the Financial
- 10 Management Act of 1979; PROVIDED, however, that no funds appropriated
- 11 hereunder shall be allotted until the Secretary of Finance has
- 12 certified to the President and the Congress the deposit of \$192,655
- 13 in the General Fund from the Office of Territorial and Insular
- 14 Affairs, United States Department of the Interior. The allottee
- 15 shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose
- 17 specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred in
- 18 excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to
- 19 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September
- 20 30, 1989.

1	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
2	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
3	law without such approval.
