A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 6-24 by amending sections 5 and 6 for the purpose of requiring a three-forths affirmative vote of all of the four State delegations on final reading and deleting the budget preparation by the Pre-Convention Committee, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 5 of Public Law No. 6-24 is hereby amended 2 to read as follows:
- 3 "Section 5. Pre-Convention Committee.
 - (1) There shall be a Pre-Convention Committee which shall consist of two members from each State who are selected by a majority vote of that State's delegation. Such selection shall be made no later than March 19, 1990, and shall be made in writing by the State's delegation to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia.
 - (2) The Pre-Convention Committee shall choose its own officers and shall organize according to its own rules and procedures.
 - (3) The duties of the Pre-Convention Committee shall be as follows:
 - (a) To make arrangements for accommodations, equipment and facilities; PROVIDED, however, that the Pre-Convention Committee shall whenever possible arrange to utilize National Government equipment and facilities;
 - (b) To make arrangements for staff; PROVIDED, however, that each State delegation to the Convention shall be permitted to bring no more than two technical staff to assist their respective delegations and the Convention;
 - Led to prepare a budget for the constitutional convent tion to be submitted to constess in the May session of 1990;
 - (\underline{dc}) To confer with the various State delegations to

1	identify those issues that each delegation wishes to raise
2	at the Convention;
3	(éd) To commission any research that it feels should
4	be performed on issues identified by the State delegations
5	prior to the convening of the Convention;
6	$(f_{\underline{e}})$ To specify a date for convening the
7	Convention;
8	(gf) To prepare proposed rules and procedures; and
9	($rac{1}{2}$) To perform other functions not otherwise
10	reserved to the Convention which will assure a successful
11	and orderly Convention.
12	(4) Members and staff of the Pre-Convention Committee
13	shall be entitled to per diem and travel expenses at
14	standard rates, as provided by the Financial Management
15	Regulations of the National Government of the Federated
16	States of Micronesia, while on the business of the
17	Committee.
18	(5) Staff assistance for the Pre-Convention Committee
19	shall be provided as needed through the National Government
20	of the Federated States of Micronesia, unless otherwise
21	provided by State delegations.
22	(6) The Pre-Convention Committee shall complete its
23	work in no more than 15 calendar days."
24	Section 2. Section 6 of Public Law No. 6-24 is hereby amended
25	to read as follows:

1	"Section 6. Procedures.
2	(1) The Constitutional Convention shall convene in
3	Palikir, Pohnpei State, at the National Capital in July of
4	1990 and shall continue in session there for not longer
5	than 30 calendar days, PROVIDED, however:
6	(a) That the Convention may call recesses; and
7	(b) May extend the session if necessary for up
8	to a total of 45 calendar days.
9	(2) The President of the Federated States of
10	Micronesia shall act as President of the Convention until
11	the Convention shall select a President from among its
12	membership.
13	(3) The Convention shall select, from among its
14	membership, a President and such additional officers as it
15	may deem necessary and appropriate.
16	(4) The Convention shall adopt its own rules of
17	procedure not inconsistent with this act; PROVIDED,
18	however, that no amendment to the Constitution of the
19	Federated States of Micronesia shall be proposed by the
20	Convention unless the proposed amendment shall have passed
21	two readings on separate days, a quorum being present. To
22	pass first reading the affirmative votes of not less than
23	three-fourths of all of the delegates shall be required.
24	On timal teading the attituative votes of all of the tout
25	State delegations shall be tedulited. On final reading the

1	affirmative votes of three-fourths of the State delegations
2	shall be required.
3	(5) A quorum of the Convention shall consist of all
4	of the four State delegations. For the purpose of
5	determining a quorum, a State delegation is not present
6	unless more than one-half of the delegates from that State
7	are present."
8	Section 3. This act shall become law upon approval by the
9	President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its becoming
10	law without such approval.
