A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 4-28, Chuuk State public projects, as amended, by further amending section 2, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 4-43, 4-64, 4-67, 4-97, 4-112, 5-10, 5-130 and 6-31, for the purpose of modifying the use of the funds appropriated therein, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 4-28, as amended by  
2 Public Laws Nos. 4-43, 4-64, 4-67, 4-97, 4-112, 5-10, 5-130 and 6-31,  
3 is hereby further amended to read as follows:


