A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend title 4 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia, as amended by Public Laws Nos. 5-12, 5-125 and 5-135, by amending section 104 to provide that the Chief Justice may give special assignments from a roster of special judges pursuant to section 9(b) of article XI of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA: 1 Section 1. Section 104 of title 4 of the Code of the Federated 2 States of Micronesia is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "Section 104. Special assignments. The Chief Justice may give special assignments from a special roster of judges pursuant to article XI, section 9(b) of the Constitution. 5 In the case of temporary Justices appointed pursuant to this authority: (1) The person appointed shall meet the 8 qualifications of section 107 of this chapter. 9 (2) Whenever the prompt and efficient dispatch of the 10 business of the Court requires additional temporary 11 Justices, the Chief Justice may give special assignments in 12 accordance with the provisions of this section. The 13 President shall appoint, with the advice and consent of 14 Congress, special judges to be available to serve 15 temporarily in the Court for special assignments. The 16 Chief Justice shall maintain a roster of these appointed 17 18 and approved judges known as a roster of special judges. (23) The Congress may by resolution disapprove of the 19 continued service of any temporary Justice selected from a 20 special roster of judges whose cumulative service exceeds 21
 - (23) The Congress may by resolution disapprove of the continued service of any temporary Justice selected from a special roster of judges whose cumulative service exceeds three months, and the disapproved person shall thereafter be ineligible for further service as a temporary Justice for one year, unless the Congress shall sooner revoke its disapproval.

(34) The Chief Justice shall give notice to the President and the Congress upon the appointment of any temporary Justice." Section 2.
