## A BILL FOR AN ACT

To propose an amendment to section 3 of article XI of the Constitution of the Federated States of Micronesia to provide that Justices will serve for a period of time not to exceed the age of 70 years old, and for other purposes.

	BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
1	Section 1. Proposed amendment. It is hereby proposed that
2	section 3 of article XI of the Constitution of the Federated States
3	of Micronesia be amended to read as follows:
4	"Section 3. The Chief Justice and associate justices of the
5	Supreme Court are appointed by the President with the
6	approval of 2/3 of Congress. Justices serve during good
7	behavior, but not for a period of time exceeding the age of
8	70 years old."
9	Section 2. Procedure. Upon this act becoming law, the proposed
10	constitutional amendment set out in section 1 will become a part of
11	the Constitution after completion of procedures and ratification as
12	required by chapter 7 of title 1 of the Code of the Federated States
13	of Micronesia.
14	Section 3. Effective date. This act shall become law upon
15	approval by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia
16	or upon its becoming law without such approval.
