A BILL FOR AN ACT

To amend Public Law No. 6-24 by amending section 8 to provide that the Convention shall propose amendments to the Constitution to be placed on a ballot for a referendum to be held at a later date, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- Section 1. Section 8 of Public Law No. 6-24 is hereby amended 2 to read as follows:
- 3 "Section 8. Duties of the Convention.
 - (1) The Convention shall propose amendments to the Constitution to be placed on a ballot for a referendum to be held diffing the general election of Match 1991; PROVIDED; Nowefet; that in the effect that an amendment would effect the general election; the amendment of amendment sould shall be fored on in a special felteridum called by the President of the Federated States of Micronesia for December of 1990 at a later date.
 - (2) Proposed amendments to the Constitution shall be in the format set forth in the Constitutional Amendment Procedure Act, title 1, section 703 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia and any regulations pursuant thereto.
 - (3) When said amendments have been proposed by the Convention, the Convention shall notify the President of the Federated States of Micronesia who shall transmit a copy of the amendments to the Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia, and shall call a referendum as provided by title 1, chapter 7 of the Code of the Federated States of Micronesia."
