CONGRESSIONAL BILL NO. 6-99, C.D.1

Public Law No. 6 - 26

AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$55,000 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1990, for the purpose of funding the preparation of land for the construction of housing for Australian Naval Advisors to the Pacific Patrol Boat program of the Division of Marine Surveillance of the Federated States of Micronesia, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. The sum of \$55,000, or so much thereof as may be
- 2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September
- 4 30, 1990, for the purpose of funding the preparation of land for the
- 5 construction of housing for Australian Naval Advisors to the Pacific
- 6 Patrol Boat program of the Division of Marine Surveillance of the
- 7 Federated States of Micronesia as provided by a Memorandum of Under-
- 8 standing between the Government of Australia and the Government of
- 9 the Federated States of Micronesia.
- 10 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be allotted,
- 11 managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance with applicable
- 12 law, including, but not limited to, the Financial Management Act of
- 13 1979. The allottee shall be the President of the Federated States
- 14 of Micronesia who shall be responsible for ensuring that these funds,
- 15 or so much thereof as may be necessary, are used solely for the
- 16 purpose specified in this act, and that no obligations are incurred
- 17 in excess of the sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to
- 18 obligate funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September
- 19 30, 1990.
