A RESOLUTION

Respectfully requesting the President of the Federated States of Micronesia to expedite the process of nominating a Micronesian for the position of Chief Justice of the Federated States of Micronesia.

- 1 WHEREAS, the judicial power of the National Government is vested
- 2 in the Supreme Court and the Chief Justice is the chief administrator
- 3 of the National judicial system; and
- WHEREAS, article XI, section 11 of the Constitution of the
- 5 Federated States of Micronesia states that "Court decisions shall be
- 6 consistent with this Constitution, Micronesian customs and traditions,
- 7 and the social and geographical configuration of Micronesia."; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Federated States of Micronesia has never had a
- 9 Micronesian as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court. Our judicial
- 10 system will never reflect the customs and traditions of our country
- 11 without a Micronesian Chief Justice of the Supreme Court; now,
- 12 therefore,
- 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixth Congress of the Federated States of
- 14 Micronesia, Third Regular Session, 1990, that the Congress hereby
- 15 respectfully requests the President of the Federated States of
- 16 Micronesia to expedite the process of nominating a Micronesian for
- 17 the position of Chief Justice of the Federated States of Micronesia;
- 18 and
- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution
- 20 be transmitted to the President of the Federated States of Micronesia.
