## AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$24,546,772 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1992, for the operations of the executive branch, legislative branch, judicial branch, Public Auditor, agencies of the National Government, and for special programs, grants, subsidies, contributions, and refunds of the National Government during fiscal year 1992; to establish a budget for Compact sections 214(b), 215(a)(2), 216(a)(1), 216(a)(2), 216(a)(3), and 221(b) and to appropriate special funds available therefore under the Compact; to establish a development budget and to appropriate and authorize special funds available therefore under the Compact; to establish employment ceilings; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:
