A BILL FOR AN ACT

To appropriate the sum of \$25,885 from the General Fund of the Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1994, for the purpose of reimbursing the Office of the President for money reprogrammed from elsewhere in the executive branch and used to fund the Chuuk State special election held in February, 1994, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

- 1 Section 1. The sum of \$25,885, or so much thereof as may be
- 2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the
- 3 Federated States of Micronesia for the fiscal year ending
- 4 September 30, 1994, for the purpose of reimbursing the Office of
- 5 the President for money reprogrammed from elsewhere in the
- 6 executive branch and used to fund the Chuuk State special
- 7 election held in February, 1994. The reprogramming used to
- 8 consolidate these funds and, to the extent the funds
- 9 appropriated hereby are returned to the account from which they
- 10 came, the reprogramming used to accomplish such redistribution
- 11 shall not be taken into account in calculating fiscal year 1994
- 12 reprogramming ceilings.
- 13 Section 2. All funds appropriated by this act shall be
- 14 allotted, managed, administered, and accounted for in accordance
- 15 with applicable law, including, but not limited to, the
- 16 Financial Management Act of 1979. The allottee shall be
- 17 responsible for ensuring that these funds, or so much thereof as
- 18 may be necessary, are used solely for the purpose specified in
- 19 this act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess of the
- 20 sum appropriated. The authority of the allottee to obligate
- 21 funds appropriated by this act shall lapse as of September
- 22 30, 1994.
